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Description

In this class, we will be looking at the life and ministry of Paul, with a concentration on Paul's epistle to the Ephesians. In Paul's epistle to the Ephesians, he conveys his pastoral heart for the Ephesian believers by focusing upon who they are in Christ as it relates to their struggles, their new life, community, pursuits of unity and holiness, and how to engage life's challenges. This class will give practical answers to basic questions about the Christian life and our identity in Christ. This study will help students understand the importance of finding identity in Christ and will help them understand the relationship between themselves and God and their spiritual walk. When not studying in Ephesians, the class will be participating in local mission and outreach opportunities.

Objectives

Before leaving this class, students will:

* have a better understanding of who they are in Christ

- * have a better understanding of how a Christian should act and respond in all situations
- * students will gain a better understanding of what missions look like. They will also have the opportunity to participate in mission/outreach work.

Required Materials

Grades

Notebook Grade, Participation, and Attendance 50%
