At CLC we are able to introduce students from public school to spiritual material that they can't discuss in their public classes. This year, the CLC offers classes from 6th grade through 12th grade.

Benefits of CLC

Having this class offers you many possible blessings: the chance to learn more than you ever thought possible about God and the Bible, the encouragement that comes by being around fellow students who also believe in God, the refreshing break in your school schedule, and most of all you will have the chance to meet and know God.

What we expect of students:

The opportunity to take CLC is a gift from God, and it is the responsibility of all of us to use His gifts wisely.

- Be respectful of the staff and each other
- Do not use cell phones (or headphones) during class time
- Clean up after yourself in the building and on the bus
- Do not dip or chew tobacco at CLC. Smoking is also prohibited including vaping and the use of Juuls or anything similar.
- No public displays of affection
- Do not spray any fragrance or use any lotions with fragrance in the building or bus.

What else do you need to know?

About Gilmer County Schools:

To help our program succeed we work closely with the Gilmer County School System. We support the school's activities, and we follow its policies as much as possible in our setting. Those policies include grading and attendance.

About Snacks:

You will normally be allowed to have snacks in class, as long as you clean up after yourself. This is a privilege we extend to help you enjoy your experience at CLC. This privilege will be removed if you abuse it. Please clean up your snacks and do not disrupt class with them. All snacks should be purchased before class begins. Snacks will not be sold during class. You cannot purchase "extra" snacks to take to friends or to eat later in the day. Extra drinks cannot be

taken from the CLC building. All drinks must be consumed before leaving the CLC building or thrown away. CLC cannot save drinks for students from one class to another.

About Honesty:

Christianity and cheating don't go together. Therefore, we are a glad participant in the Gilmer County School System academic honesty policy. Any work done as a group must receive prior approval. If there is any doubt, it is not group work. Remember, what you put into the class is what you will get out of it.

About Releasing the Student during Class:

It is our policy to never allow a student to leave our building with anyone unless the front office at Clear Creek Middle School has called us to let us know you are leaving with the approved adult. The adult must first go to CCMS, sign you out of CCMS, then CCMS will call the CLC, and then you can be picked up at CLC- or we can drive you to CCMS to be checked out. If you must leave early for an appointment or event, and have a school approved permission slip, the CLC will return you to CCMS in a timely manner.

About Attitude:

We don't expect you to agree with everything everyone says in your class, but we do ask you to be respectful to your teacher and your fellow classmates. We also ask that you have a teachable spirit.

Anything Else:

We are so glad you are here! We are praying for you and care about you. If you have questions about Christianity, the Bible, God, or anything else, we are here to help.
