COURSE OVERVIEW

This semester is designed to ground students in God's Word, strengthen their personal walk with Christ, and teach them how to live as missional believers: seeing everyday life as an opportunity to love others, serve well, and share the Gospel. Students will be encouraged to look beyond themselves and learn how God can use them to impact their schools, families, and communities for His Kingdom.

COURSE OVERVIEW (EACH DAY)

Mondays & Wednesdays – The Book of Acts

On Mondays and Wednesdays, we will journey through the book of Acts, studying the birth and growth of the early Church. We will explore how the Holy Spirit empowered ordinary believers to do extraordinary things, how the Gospel spread, how persecution was faced with courage, and how God used faithful obedience to change the world. Students will learn what it means to live as bold witnesses of Christ in their own generation.

Tuesdays – The Believer's Toolbox

Tuesdays will focus on spiritual "tools" every believer should carry in their toolbox. These lessons will be practical and personal, helping students grow in areas such as:

Renewing the mind, celebrating others, walking in victory, steadfastness, and perseverance

These tools are meant to equip students to face challenges, build healthy relationships, and live with confidence in Christ.

Thursdays – Heroes of the Faith

On Thursdays, we will study missionaries and heroes of the faith who helped spread the Gospel across the globe. Through their stories, students will see how God uses faithful people from every background to impact nations, overcome hardship, and advance His Kingdom.

Outreach & Service

Throughout the semester, students will also participate in outreach projects. These opportunities will allow them to put their faith into action by serving others, sharing the love of Christ, and being the hands and feet of Jesus in our community.

GRADING POLICY

Each week students will receive a grade that reflects both their learning and their growth. These grades will come from worksheets, writing assignments, missionary notebooks, and participation in class.

Outreach projects will count as test grades because they give students the opportunity to live out what they are learning by serving others and sharing Christ in real, meaningful ways.
